Last week, I went on vacation with the wife and kids to visit family in Florida and celebrate Thanksgiving. After being gone 5 days, it feels like I'm 10 days behind schedule (which is part of the reason why this newsletter is delayed a couple days. Having to cancel last Sunday's activities (due to the weather) did give me a slight reprieve, but it's now Advent and things are about to get even busier.

Advent is that special time of year where we prepare for our Savior's second Advent by celebrating and remembering our Lord's first Advent over 2000 years ago. Things have changed over the past year at Bethany. And because I wasn't here this time last year, there's a good chance that Advent and Christmastide are going to look a little different than they have in the past. For starters, we won't be having an 11:00 PM Candlelight Service this year. On December 24<sup>th</sup>, we'll have our regular Sunday morning Worship Service at 9:00 AM and will have our Christmas Eve Service (with Holy Communion) at 7:00 PM. Monday morning, December 25<sup>th</sup>, we'll have our Christmas Day Service (with Holy Communion) at 10:00 AM.

On Wednesday evenings (12/6, 12/13, & 12/20) we'll have our mid-week Advent Services at 7:00 PM. Our theme this year is: "Advent Answers To Hard Questions hardly Anyone Is Asking." Those questions are: "The Birth of God... How and Why?", "The Obedient Child: Did He Know?" and "The Man's Man: Why Would Jesus Every Cry?". These questions may not be at the forefront of our minds during this busy holiday season, but their answers help paint the picture of God and His love for us.

At things get busier and more hectic over the coming weeks, be sure and take time to breathe and focus on what this season is all about. And as we await our Lord's second Advent, we are filled with hope and joy as we pray: Come, Lord Jesus.

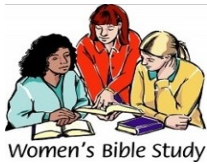

## Early Childhood Center Update

The ECC will be preparing for Christmas with a celebration on Monday, December 11th @ 6:15. The congregation is invited to see the children, decorate cookies, and enjoy hot chocolate. The congregation will be presenting each ECC child with a "My First Bible" purchased through Thrivent grant funds received this year.

Our ECC has been awarded a grant of \$109,054.00 from the Kansas Children's Cabinet and Trust Fund. The purpose of this grant is to pay for an expansion of our Staff and supporting costs through the end of June, 2024. We are about to open our Infant care room, so this grant will fund the 3 Teachers we need for that room and 2 new Teachers for the upper-age groups. The addition of the Infant room (which we have not had up until now) and the additional Teachers will allow us to fill to our licensed capacity. This grant means that we can add those Teachers without worrying if we have enough enrollment to pay for them through this coming June. Of course, we will have new enrollment, and income from that enrollment, so we will be ahead on income by whatever increase in actual enrollment that we have. The grant also pays for the cost of hiring the new Teachers, as well as training and classroom supplies. The funds should arrive any day now, so we need to get busy with the hiring process.

## Lutheran Women in Mission

**Lutheran Women in Mission** is the longest existing service group in the LCMS. LWML meets on the 2nd Tuesday of each month at 4:00 for a short business meeting and Bible Study from the current LWML Quarterly and fellowship. All women are welcome. For more information call Ruth Valdez at (316) 213-0177. Quilting ladies meet on Tuesdays at 10am and on Saturdays at 9am for quilting and fellowship.

MOST MINISTRIES have sent 9 eyeglass teams out to 7 countries this year with another team having been sent to Guatemala this November. Over 5,300 pairs of eyeglasses have been delivered to individuals in need of clear vision, many for the first time. Your donated eyeglasses brought thousands of people through the MOST clinics; eyeglasses draw people in who might never step foot in a Christian church. It's beautiful to witness someone hearing about Jesus for the first time and also when you hear a loud "WOW" as someone can see clearly for the first time. Their life has been changed not only as they can see but also as they begin to know about their Savior Jesus.

An important part of the clinics is eye protection and eye drops due to the swirling dust, intense sun and cooking over an open fire in most of the villages where the clinics are held. These two items help reduce some of the preventable eye diseases the clinics encounter. Each person coming into the clinic receives an eye dropper with a simple solution recipe and also non-prescription sunglasses. Nearly 6,000 pairs of non-prescription sunglasses and eyedroppers have been handed out so far this year. The clinics have depleted their stock of the non-prescription sunglasses and are in need of them as they start preparing for their 2024 eyeglasses teams.

So, along with continuing to collect used prescription eyeglasses and sunglasses, we will also be collecting non-prescription sunglasses, both of which can be placed in the brown box on the LWML table in the Narthex.
