Trustees Report


We are diligently working on the camera system installation. To date, we have had occasion to provide camera footage to the Wichita Police Department with information that could prove helpful. These cameras will help us keep members safe from unwanted visitors and possibly offer footage for our neighborhood.

With the plans to expand the ECC, the volunteers are working to remodel rooms and have created a temporary "room" in the activity center. At this time, it is unknown the length of time the temporary set up will be needed. All parties that use the activity center will be instructed on how to use the activity center.

Thanks go out to the volunteers that give of their time and talents to benefit Bethany.

We are working on a fund that will benefit repair/replacement of heating and air units. Stay tuned for details as things progress. All for now. Trustees







Early Childhood Center Update

As you have heard, our ECC has been awarded a grant for \$109,000 to pay for the expansion of our Daycare. The money will be used to cover the cost of the 3 Teachers needed to staff the new Infant Care room, along with training for them and supplies for the room. Also, it will pay for 2 additional Teachers in the older classrooms, so we can take more kids in those rooms. The catch is, we have to get the Infant room ready first... We have done a LOT of work to acquire proper blueprints to modify the old Sunflower Room (where the younger kids are now) to become the Infant room. This has meant working with

an architect and the State Fire Marshall and KDHE and City Inspections. We

have lined-up our plans and materials. To do the work, we need to first move the youngest children out of that room temporarily while the work is begin done. To do that, we first had to do the whole 4-step planning process to set up temporary (for a week or two) quarters for those children in the Activity Center. That has been done, and we now have a date of January 3rd for the State Fire Marshall to inspect that room and temporary classroom set-up so we can start the work. Once the work is done, we can have it inspected and open the room. THEN we can staff it. So, you can see that there are a lot of moving pieces to this enterprise, and we have to work with and around other entities to make all this happen. Please keep praying for us as we work through all this, and we THANK YOU for your continuing support!

I have struggled in the past with the end of the growing season when all of the plants are dead. Coming to terms I now believe that God put the seasons in motion for reasons. 
