



# Early Childhood Center Update



Bethany's Early Childhood Center is perking right along, and life here is good.

Our quest to open the new Infant room is taking longer than expected due to all the inter-coordinating layers of regulation and inspection. We have to deal with both State and Local agencies in a multi-step process. The extreme cold weather is another obstacle to work around, as opening a hole in our wall to put the new door in is not something to do in sub-freezing weather. Then the workers have to be arranged... It's quite an undertaking for what would seem to be a simple

project. Our current target for opening the Infant room is March 1st. To staff the new Infant room, and to allow growth in the upper-age classrooms, we have now begun the hiring process! We need to hire a total of 5 Teachers for all the positions funded by the expansion grant through the end of June. We have an online ad out now and we are receiving applications -- please pray for

our success in this process.

## **Stewardship Report:**

Our income for 2023 was \$578,717 and our expenses were \$580,227. We were blessed by \$73,000 in child care grant funds to help cover expenses. For 2024 we will get reimbursed for what we spend on hiring new teachers and supplies to increase our daycare capacity. Unfortunately the new grant money can't be used for paying our building insurance so we will still have to come up with the quarterly premium of approximately \$4,000 plus the buydown of the deductible of approximately \$8,800 dollars by March 1st.


