


Early Childhood Center Update

We are finally making progress on our new infant room! The hang-up has been the multi -agency governmental approval and inspection progress, and when one agency lost our paperwork, that took even more time. But they finally did what they are supposed to do, and so things are HAPPENING now! The Toddler class was moved into our Activity Center temporarily to get them out of the construction zone, and construction started on

the new Infant/Toddler room. Every step of this has required KDHE and Fire Marshall approval.

So, the demolition has been done, the new wall has been studded-in, the plumbing is done except for fixture installation, the new outdoor sidewalk has been poured, and now the electrical work is being done and the new doorway has been cut. Yes, the expected completion date has been pushed back for several months, but now it won't take "too long" to get the actual work done so we can open the room.

Bethany's Community Garden

March 19 is the official first day of spring. Great News!! Our garden is expanding from 847 sq. ft. to 1127 sq. ft. The additional 280 sq. ft. is the same as 10 feet by

28 feet of new ground. How can you help: donations, planting, weeding, and maintenance. My vision for our garden this year is to add more flowers and herbs. There will be plenty of cut flowers for all us to enjoy. We now have a 43 gallon compost tumbler to make our own compost. The literature says it only takes 2-3 weeks to decompose. This will save money through the season. The composter comes with a wheel barrow that fits under it making it easy to empty Egg shells, coffee grounds, fresh grass clippings, straw, leaves are safe to use. As long as you haven't used any weed killer on your lawn. There's a lot of stuff that cannot be added. Please check with me. Soon the garden will be in its glory, full of life. We need to replace that unit before the season to protect the other units from overuse to cool the sanctuary. This is not an item that was in the current work program. The quotes we have range from \$6 to 8 thousand dollars.

We do have the option of using our line of credit to purchase this unit. We have a current bid of \$6,000 to replace the unit from a reputable company. We would like to hire this company to order the unit and schedule installation in the next couple of weeks.
