Early Childhood Center Update



Good news and frustration are carrying our Early Childhood Center into summer. The good news is that enrollment has increased over the last couple of months, so we now have 47 children enrolled. The frustration is that while we have had our new Infant room ready for weeks and weeks, it is still not open for 1 (one) reason only -- the Kansas Dept. of Health and Environment (the state regulator of all daycare services) has not given us our final inspection and official okay to open. They blame a cyber-breach of their system for the delay. Our local KDHE Surveyor (Inspector) feels badly about this and has promised to come and give us the inspection and approval to open the same day she gets the call from Topeka authorizing her to do so. The very next day, we will have that new room OPEN to take in 8 babies, for a total enrollment of 55.

Meanwhile, the grant funding has allowed us to fully prepare for the new Infant room AND it has allowed us to add Teachers so that we can have more kids in the older-age classrooms. Before, we were topped-out at 40 children as that was all we could have with the number of Teachers we had. With the new hires funded by the grant, we have already added 7 kids and we have room for 5 more. Our current license limits us to 60 children in total.

Please continue to pray for us, and ask for an end to the bureaucratic roadblock we are currently experiencing. Thank you for your prayers and support!

On June 17, five children from the ECC watched me plant okra seeds. The sprouts are two inches tall. The children wanted to see them. They are fired up about the garden. I explained to them that the little sprouts will grow to be six

feet tall. They say they are ready to eat some okra.

In the month of June, I spent four days in the hospital with pneumonia. It took a total of 16 days before I could even set in a chair and watch everyone else work in the garden. Today is June 25, and I'm able to do more and more each day. Without the dedicated workers who love the garden as much as I do there would be no garden. They spent hours and days keeping the grass and weeds under control. Taking care of young plants so they grow up to be healthy. There is always something more that needs to be done. 
