The Management Team was aware of the financial difficulties faced by the ECC due to the construction, inspection, and final clearance of the new infant room all being late. Those delays caused the loss of several children and infants that were waiting for the infant room to open. The Team planned to address the problem by requesting the congregation approve using a Line of Credit to serve as a safety net for the ECC. That net is in place and as of last week some funds have been drawn down.

Trustees Report

Thanksgiving is upon us! We truly have many things to be thankful for and praise Him!

As you enter/exit the south doors, you might notice freshly painted doors and trim. Another item to update and elongate our aging building. This has been funded through your gracious giving to the "Legacy "campaign. New guttering is scheduled post Thanksgiving, weather permitting. Guttering on the south canopy and Narthex.

We have 11 more months of giving not needed for the original scope. Prayerfully, donations will continue throughout.

Upon working through the painting preparation, we have found the entrance door frame is terribly rusted. This opening was new in 1989. This needs to be addressed in the near future. Stayed tuned for updates. Efforts now go inside to attack needed repairs and maintenance.

Things continue to improve in our ECC here at Bethany. Enrollment has ticked slightly upward, currently giving us 5 babies in our Infant room, which has 8 spaces total. We expect this situation to improve after the holidays. We recently lost our cook, who moved on to other things, but we are not hiring anyone for that job right now -- we are covering those cooking duties with other staff. This saves a few dollars on expenses. We are losing one of our Teachers in the Infant room as she moves on to a better-paying job that's closer to home. We will begin the hiring process to replace her in January, so we are temporarily moving a couple of other Teachers around to cover that position for the next few weeks. You need to know that in her exit interview,

that Teacher praised our ECC as "...an amazing place to work, with the best management!" She would like to come back if her family finances improve, and we would like to have her back.

You may have noticed our new fence around the expanded playground. This new, better-quality fence both replaces worn-down fencing AND it includes more area for a bigger playground. Being taller, it gives us more security against fence-jumpers. This fence was paid for by the daycare expansion grant we got from the Children's Cabinet & Trust Fund, along with \$500 added by a memorial gift.

Bethany's Garden - Come Grow with Us!

Fall is almost over and the official first day of winter is December 21. The transition into winter can cause uncertainty of what is to come. I was harvesting gallons of cherry tomatoes up to November 20. For the growing season to last so long I was able to harvest more. I will be picking eighteen cabbages the last week in November. Toni and I planted a total of 102 daffodils, irises and tulips. The daffodils will bloom in February and March as the first sign of spring.

The history of the garden started on April 2, 2016 with six raised beds. The following members dug the well including: Mark Welty, Dwan Welty, Chuck Payne, Robert Ohmie, David Funke, Bruce Kester and Dale Kester. Dale Kester made the Community Garden sign over the entrance of the garden. Robert Ohmie and Mark Welty built the six raised beds. In the beginning, 2016, the garden was 126 sq. ft. For the past four years (2021-2024) we have expanded each year and now the garden is 1,413 sq. ft. of growing space. Now it is time for the soil to rest through the winter. 
