Please note that the church's positive cash flow has been used to partially offset the ECC's losses. The positive cash flow is the result of increased giving by the congregation, IRS tax refund, the Infant Room Grant paying 43.03% of the cost of insurance, gas, water, and electricity for six months and memorial funds repaying the church for work previously done on their behalf.

The remaining amount was funded with Designated Funds.

On December 31, 2024, Bethany owed \$20,000 to the Line of Credit, and its Designated Funds \$12,961.61.

The intent is by mid-2025 to start paying back all of these funds.

#### **Trustees Report**

We welcome a bit warmer weather!

We have plowed snow when needed and treated for ice in attempt to allow safe entry/exit to the church. That, of course, becomes pricey! Our snow guy (Bruce Gilder) works with us to keep expenses down. Difficult with the storms we have had.

We had some issues with boiler start up. Seems to be operating. Be it known, this will likely be the last heating season for the boiler. Too many issues with piping and boiler to effectively repair. Process under way to make plans to offer different options for heat before next winter. Stay tuned for updates.

Our current enrollment is 40 full-time children.

We are working on getting ourselves published on the Military Child Care website as an approved daycare provider for families who cannot get their kids into the MCC Daycare Center on McConnell Air Force Base. The MCC Center at McConnell is FULL and has a waiting list...they vet outside child care providers and provide that information to military families who need daycare services. If we can get published on that list,

that by itself will put our information in front of a LOT of families who are looking for daycare. This would be an awesome "in" that should really help enrollment. Stay tuned...


