I could have sworn I just finished typing my article for **September's** newsletter a few days ago. So much has happened in **ONE** month! **Blink.** It's **October**! To highlight what's been going on:

- By the grace of God, over \$71,000 of the over \$88,000 that was pledged has come in (see graph below).
- We broke ground on Sep. 10<sup>th</sup> (see page 9 for pics).
- The new driveway was poured Sep. 14<sup>th</sup> (see page 4).
- The 5 wrought iron fence sections were sandblasted and powder coated. They look better than new and were re-installed Sep. 26<sup>th</sup> (see page 4).
- Additional signage was installed to help our guests and visitors more easily navigate the building (see below).

God's been doing some amazing things but there is still more to come:

- The sprinkler system is going to be installed in the next week or two.
- Once the sprinkler is installed, we'll be doing some new landscaping to help increase our curb appeal.
- We're still working with LED sign companies to finalize a bid and hope to have the new LED sign installed before Christmas.
- Plans are happening to remodel the Toddler/Preschool 1 rooms so our ECC is able to accept infants (see plan below).



### **Trustees Report**

Many thanks to the specialists that made short work of leveling the dirt and doing some landscaping! Ready for the sprinkler system!! It looks GREAT!!

We hope to be out of A/C need soon. Point...one of the four A/C units for the sanctuary needs to be replaced. We plan to hold off the replacement until early spring. Costs today are in the \$8,000 range. We hope to get better pricing in the off season. Please note, this is something we need to include in the '24 work program or fund separately.

You will note work in the courtyard... Stone caps and sills cleaned. Iron fence powder coated. On going trimming/caring for plants and shrubs. Thankful for the donated funds and volunteers that make things work!

We have had multiple acts of vandalism in our parking lot. At this time, we are not replacing the signage. Seems that we are on a possible "Tik-Toc" circuit... So, we are not willing to keep replacing signs to be targets. Police reports have been filed.

**PRAYER CENTER - Robert Bolin** leads a study on how the Lutheran Church differs in its understanding of the Sacrament of Communion from other Christian groups and on what biblical writings that understanding is based.

**MEET & EAT ROOM**– Mark Dehncke's class is reviewing Luther's Small Catechism. Note the classroom location change. By the way, if you have ever wondered why this book is called a catechism, the reason is the word comes from the Greek verb "katecheo" - "to teach orally".

Topic changes weekly. **YOUTH AND KIDS - SUNDAY SCHOOL includes ages Preschool to age 17.** Teachers are Ruth Valdez and Deb Welty with assistance of Tonya Cordt. An opening is held at 10:30 in the back of the Sanctuary with music led by Sandy Tope. Lesson and activity is in the Youth Room in basement.

### **Early Childhood Center Update**

Life is good in our ECC Daycare! Enrollment is steady, but could be better, running in the 30-something range. With our current staffing, we can take about 10 more kids at any time, to fill to our capacity of 44. Our numbers always fluctuate, as that is how daycare is everywhere...people's needs for services come and go.


Grant applications: We now have 3 grants that we have applied for. We hope to tell you next month exactly what we will get. The grants are: 1) A \$7,200 grant for general expenses, to offset the cost of caring for the children whose tuition is paid by DCF. About half of our families receive DCF funding, so the \$7,200 is what the State figures we deserve. This grant is from Child Care Aware, using Kansas DCF money. 2) A grant for \$9,756 to pay for cribs and rockers for our new Infant Room and fliers and supplies for our ECC family night festivities we hold several times a year. This grant is from our LCMS Kansas District, using money from our fellow Lutherans. 3) A grant for \$78,206 for operational costs for expanding our Daycare by 31 slots for children. This grant is for staff, training, advertising and supply costs only, and cannot be used for construction. This grant is from the Kansas Children's Cabinet and Trust Fund, a public-private consortium. If approved, we would spend this money to pay for the 5 new Teacher jobs, 3 being in our soon-to-open Infant room and 2 in our older-age classrooms. These 5 positions, when filled, would allow us to add the 9 infants we are planning on (1 Teacher for each 3 babies) and 10 more kids in each of the 2 oldest age groups. This would fund the new jobs until June of next year, when the grant ends. We already have one Infant Teacher ready to go, and we would have to newly hire the others.

That's it for now, but keep watching - things are Happening at Bethany and in our Daycare!!




