While this verse is in response to Thomas doubting that Jesus was truly resurrected, the same sentiment could have been applied to me a month ago when considering our "Fulfilling The Dream, Continuing The Legacy" campaign. To that end, next Sunday, September 10th after our worship service, we're going to go outside and break ground on the next chapter of what God is going to do here at Bethany. With the guidance and blessing of the Holy Spirit, we are "Fulfilling The Dream" that began here almost 70 years ago and "Continuing The Legacy" for generations to come. That legacy of faith was given to us through Baptism and fostered by our parents and grandparents. By the grace of God, we have the honor and privilege of passing on that witness to not only our children and grandchildren, but to whomever God gives us the opportunity to share His love with.

Thank you for inviting me to join you on the incredible journey God has laid out for Bethany.

Bethany's Daycare(our Early Childhood Center) is enjoying the summer. As older siblings go back to school for the year they are not available to watch their little brothers and sisters, so the younger children in families tend to need daycare services again. We will know by the end of August just how much of a bump in enrollment we will get from this phenomenon this year.

We are excited about the new construction project for the new driveway and front entrance! We look forward to incorporating this improvement into the flow of our Daycare facilities as we slowly develop our existing spaces to add infant care and realign our care of older children. It would be so wonderful if we could concentrate our daycare operations in the west end of the building and have a dedicated entrance for our children and families that would be accessed from the new front driveway. Such an arrangement would enhance the safety and convenience of our students and staff by centralizing control over who comes and goes in our building..

HELP WANTED: We are looking for a new Cook for our Daycare. Daycare experience is helpful but is not required. A Food-Handler's card is not required - we will get the new employee exactly what they need. This is a part-time job FOR PAY. The hours are roughly around lunchtime. The duties include making a hot lunch and prepping breakfast for the next day. Dependability is a must. **We may be able to accommodate a job-sharing arrangement if you are the right candidate but you cannot work 5 days a week.** If you or someone you know is interested, contact the Church office and we will get in touch!


