

Early Childhood Center

Bethany's Daycare had 45 children enrolled during March, and by the time you see this, we will have 47 children. 1 of those new ones is an infant. So, we ARE seeing growth, albeit not as fast as we would like. Please continue to pray for growth in our enrollment!

We have implemented an increase in our tuition for all age levels, effective March 31st. This increase is in step with the whole daycare industry in our area, as everyone's prices keep slowly going up. We were getting to be a real bargain, price-wise, so this increase keeps us about middle-of-the-road in pricing. The parental reaction to this price increase is accepting, maybe

even positive. You just cannot get better care anywhere for what we charge. This modest price increase will keep us competitive in pricing and employee retention.

You may have seen the new, larger surface in the playground that our Trustees recently installed. This safety surface was paid for by last year's grant from the Kansas Children's Cabinet & Trust Fund. So, things continue on an uphill trend in our ECC Daycare. Keep praying for us -- things are looking up!

Bethany's Garden - Come Grow with Us!

March 20 was the First Day of Spring and Earth Day will be on April 22. The garden is starting to wake up with color. The yellow daffodils were pretty. Three yellow tulips are blooming. The remaining tulips should be blooming in mid spring. They don't grow very tall only 14 inches to 24 inches. Starter plants that thrive in cooler temperatures need to be planted. Mainly crops in the cabbage family. We will have green and red cabbage, white and red Kohlrabi and Brussel sprouts. First time vegetables for 2025 are Armenian cucumbers, butter beans and winter squash including trombone, spaghetti and butternut. The good thing about winter squash is they repel squash bugs and squash vine borers. Not like summer squash that was destroyed by them last year. I will still plant some straight neck yellow and Zucchini. The garden will continue our favorites. Hopefully, we will enjoy a good harvest of strawberries. The garden will have more flowers and herbs. Making tea with peppermint and four different kinds of Basil are popular. Planting clover to attract honey bees. Planting African marigolds for pest control and to deter moles. The photo of the three men standing together, Mark W., Dwan W. and Bruce K. are fixing the well. The photo of three women is Diane M., Toni B. and me. Third photo is me standing in a pile of dead plants. We work hard but we have a lot of fun together. They not only give their time to do what needs to be done they freely pay for everything that it takes to have a successful garden. There are no words to describe how much they have given


Westside UMC Food Pantry
